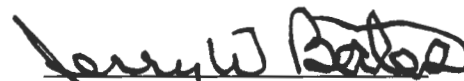

ORDER RESTRICTING OUTDOOR BURNING

WHEREAS: Due to existing drought conditions within the County of Uvalde.

It is HERBY ORDERED by the County Judge of Uvalde County that all outdoor burning is banned in the unincorporated area of the county for 90 days from today's date or by the next Commissioners Court set for September 24, 2026. The Ban on Outdoor Burning is effective at 9 AM on Thursday, September 17th, 2026.

All unincorporated areas of Uvalde County are banned from any outdoor burning during this time. This order is adopted pursuant to Local Government Code 352.081, and other applicable statues. In accordance with Local Government Code 352.081 (b) a violation of the Order is a Class C misdemeanor, punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00
