



EXTEND AND MODIFY DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER

- WHEREAS The County of Uvalde on this 14th day of July 2026 has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or property (or Imminent threat of same) resulting from severe rainfall and flooding; and
- WHEREAS County Judge of Uvalde County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property; and

NOW, TEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF UVALDE COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Uvalde County pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than thirty (30) days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Uvalde County Commissioners Court.
3. Pursuant to Section 418.108 c of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of local disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
4. Pursuant to Section 418.108 (d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of local disaster activates the county emergency management plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance
6. That this declaration shall seek any and all state and federal relief available

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance. ORDERED this 10th day of AUGUST, 2026..
